**Bedford/Manhattanville Pre-service Teacher Intern Program
Fox Lane High School/Fox Lane Middle School**

The Bedford Central Schools has a long history of supporting Manhattanville students. Manhattanville's pre-service teachers have been offered experiences in field observations, on-campus laboratory methods classes taught by Manhattanville professors through the Bedford Staff Development Center, student teacher placements, and invitations to attend on-going professional development offered by the Bedford Central Schools.

Job Description:

Bedford is seeking four (4) teacher interns from Manhattanville graduate students during the 2011-12 school year. The intern will:

- Act as substitute teachers solely for the professional staff at the Fox Lane High School or Fox Lane Middle School. When not assigned as substitutes, interns will assist students in FLHS/FLMS classrooms. This placement will be determined by the discipline of study for the intern whenever possible.
- Provide services to the Fox Lane High School or Fox Lane Middle School for the duration of the school year following the regular schedule of a teacher. This will include participation in all meetings and after school obligations of regular full-time teachers. Consideration will be offered to interns in times when attendance at graduate classes at Manhattanville conflicts with these responsibilities.
- Assist FLHS/FLMS students for three (3) after school periods each week in providing extra help, enrichment, or through participation in club and/or athletic activities.
- Enter the internship with the minimum of a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college and have gained admission to the Manhattanville School of Education for graduate level study.
- Interns are the employees of the Bedford Central Schools commencing immediately and ending 6/30/2012. The intern will be compensated at an annual salary of \$12,000. No other benefits will be provided with the exception of two (2) sick days and two (2) personal days.
