



## Self-Designed Major Application

When a student’s interests lie outside or between the areas of existing departments, he/she may propose to the School of Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee (SASCC) a self-designed major. Proposals must be presented in front of SASCC for approval before the second semester of the junior year. In most cases, self-designed majors are interdisciplinary and involve courses from two or more departments.

Students must consult with three faculty members (at least two of whom are full-time) from at least two different departments, including those from which courses are drawn. Signatures must be obtained from at least one faculty member in each departments from which courses are selected.

To apply, students must:

- Submit a Self-Designed Major Application
- Submit a rational for the self-designed major
- If the self-designed major is based on another institution’s format, please provide a website link
