INTERNATIONAL APPLICATION PROCESS

International Freshman

- ▶ Manhattanville application or Common Application
- ▶ Official high school transcripts
- ▶ Scores from one of the following:
 - Official TOEFL: 80 iBT/550 PBT
 - Official IELTS: 6.5
 - Official ACT: 25 or higher in English
 - Official SAT: 550 (Critical Reading)
 - IB: predictable score of 5 or higher on English High Level
 - AP: 4 or higher on English Language or English Literature
- ▶ Two letters of recommendation
- ▶ Personal Essay

Visa: International Students must submit financial documentation for the I-20 form to apply for F-1 Visa.

Deadlines: Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and students can apply at any time. Early action deadline: December 1st. Priority deadline: March 1st
