

## Report for American Rescue Plan Emergency Grants to Students

July 1 – September 30, 2021

Manhattanville College signed and returned to the US Department of Education the Certification and Agreement to receive Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF). The College will use the funds awarded for distribution to the College under the American Rescue Plan (ARP), \$2,357,482, (a)(1) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to eligible students.

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the ARP (a)(1) program during the quarter from July 1 to September 30, 2021 was \$839,019.72. The estimated total number of students eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants is 3582, and includes all students who are or were enrolled on or after the date that the declaration of the national emergency (March 13, 2020). Some students appear in different classifications in different applicable terms. The student makeup breaks out as follows:

Manhattanville College has awarded Emergency Financial Aid grants to 254 students who applied for assistance during this quarter. The maximum amount a student could receive was based on several factors: Pell eligibility, statement of exceptional need, status as undergraduate or graduate, and if they are a domestic or international student. The actual amount requested was then compared to the maximum allowable amount. Students who requested less than their maximum allowable will be eligible for additional grants up to the calculated maximum allowed. In compliance with the Department of Education instructions, priority was given to domestic undergraduates with exceptional need. A summary of that distribution is included in the table below:
