You are receiving the attached memorandum because you are a dean, director or department head and have been designated as a "Campus Security Authority."

New this year: To help ensure compliance with Manhattanville College's obligations under Title IX, as clarified by the Department of Education, Campus Security Authorities are required to notify any Manhattanville College student or staff member who is a victim of sexual assault by another College student or employee of their right to file a Title IX sex discrimination complaint with the College. Sexual assault constitutes an extreme form of sexual harassment which is prohibited by and actionable under Manhattanville College policy. Victims of sexual assault should be referred to the Title IX Coordinator, Carin Horowitz, at 914-323-7127.

This information has been added to the Crime Statistic Sexual Assault Report Form (attachment to this letter). Please mark the box on form if the complainant was referred to the Title IX Coordinator.

Thank you for your attention to this new guidance.

<u>Please disseminate the memorandum and attached documents to all departments and individuals</u> <u>within your administration who fit the definition of Campus Security Authority</u> and who thus have need to be aware of this responsibility. It is especially important to inform new employees of their responsibility in this capacity.



If you or any person determined to be a Campus Security Authority is aware of any crimes that occurred on campus in calendar year <u>2011</u> that were not reported Manhattanville College Campus Safety, it is important that information be forwarded to me no later than June 1st, 2012.

Please note: If a serious crime that may cause an ongoing threat to the Manhattanville College community is reported to anyone who is defined as a Campus Security Authority, that individual should not wait until the end of the year to report that incident to the Department of Campus Safety Clery Coordinator. The institution has a responsibility to notify the campus community about any crimes which may pose an ongoing threat to the community, and as such, Campus Security Authorities are obligated by law to report any crimes immediately to Department of Campus Safety. If there is any question about whether an ongoing threat exists, immediately contact me, or the Main Campus Safety Desk at (914) 323-5244 in my absence to discuss the matter further.
