

Manhattanville College received \$860,913 in funding from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) CARES Act for distribution to students. The funds were distributed to Title IV-eligible students who completed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) by the end of the 2019-2020 academic year, in varying amounts, based on the student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as calculated on the FAFSA. The total numbers of students and amounts given are summarized below.
