Based on partner agreements, students may enroll for one semester or one academic year. Application deadlines are May 1 for Fall (August semester) and November 1 for Spring (Jan).

INTERNATIONAL MOVE IN: August 22, 2022
REQUIRED PRE-ORIENTATION BEGINS: August 22, 2022
FALL SEMESTER: August 29, 2022– December 16, 2023
WINTER BREAK: December 16, 2022 - January 17, 2023
SPRING SEMESTER: January 17, 2022 - May 5, 2023
RESIDENCE MOVE OUT BY: May 7, 2023

DEPARTURE DATE: J-1 students have 30 days after classes to depart the country (plan that trip to Niagara, Disney, Vegas...)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

GPA: 3.0
PASSPORT: Valid at least six months past your time in the U.S.
TOEFL: 80 / **IETS:** 6.5 / **DUOLINGO:** 105
TRANSCRIPT: Official transcript from home institution
NOMINATIONS: Must be nominated by home institution
