New Guidance For Students Exposed to Covid-19

QUARANTINE

The process of separating an individual who has been exposed to communicable disease from others.

CONTACT

At least 15 minutes within 6 ft over a 24 hour period.

DATE OF EXPOSURE

Day 0

If you are fully vaccinated and received a booster (or if you are fully vaccinated and not yet eligible for the booster dose)

- You do not need to quarantine – but- you do need to wear a mask and monitor yourself for symptoms for 10 days after your exposure.
- If you develop symptoms prior to day 5, you do not need to wait to be tested.
- You should be tested 5-7 days after your exposure.

You should be tested 5-7 days after your exposure.

If you are fully vaccinated but have not yet received your booster and are eligible to do so OR if you are unvaccinated:

- You must enter a mandatory FULL 5 day quarantine on or off campus.
- You should monitor yourself for development of COVID symptoms for a full 10 days.
- You must be tested on day 5 in order to end your quarantine and return to campus or leave your quarantine space.
- If your quarantine ends after day 5, you must wear a well-fitted mask for an additional 5 days.
