Ample parking allows students to keep cars on campus if desired.

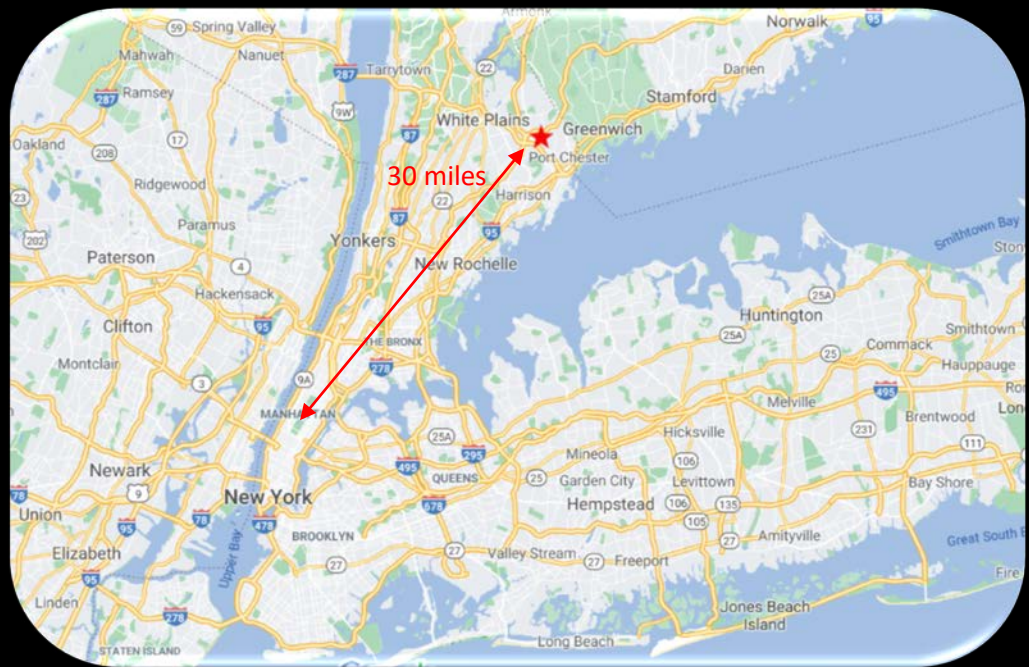
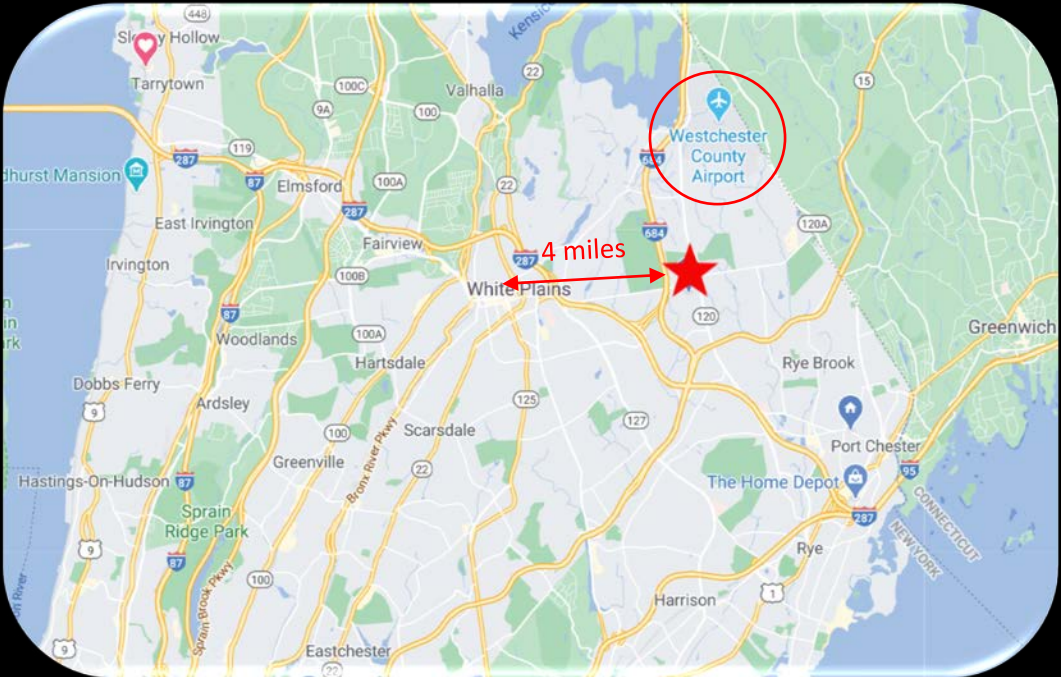
Many corporate-headquarters are in the area – great for internships.



We provide free bus service “The Valiant Express” to White Plains, the closest large city (pop. 60K) for dining and shopping. There are two malls and several shopping centers plus movies and gyms.

The public Bee-line bus also provides access to White Plains, surrounding Westchester County communities, and connects you to trains into New York City, Long Island and New Jersey.

Fun fact: you can actually take the bus to the closest airport (domestic flights only) five minutes away.



Manhattanville has an ideal suburban location offering easy access to New York City’s businesses, museums, airports and entertainment venues.

Train service to midtown Manhattan takes approximately 40 minutes from the White Plains station. Uber and Lyft also serve our area.

The Valiant Express offers free service to NYC on the weekends.
